What went well?	What to improve:	Ideas to think about:
<ol> <li>You moved around between students and used your proximity to reduce disruptive behavior. I rated you as doing this well.</li> <li>You used clear, calm redirects. I rated you as doing this well.</li> <li>Great job!</li> </ol>	<ol> <li>When you used praise, only 1 out of 3 were behavior specific. I rated this as somewhat well.</li> <li>Your ratio of praise to reprimands/redirections was 1:3. You had 3 praise statements and 9 reprimands during the time I observed.</li> </ol>	Identify one or two behaviors you want to see students use more (e.g., raising hand to answer question) and give behaviorspecific praise when it happens (e.g., "Thank you for raising your hand before answering."). This may help you increase your behavior-specific praise as you move around the room.
